ABSTRACT

This document gives the guidelines for the preparation of full papers to be submitted to GD2018. To ensure that papers are included in the proceedings, please follow the instructions. Advice on all aspects of paper presentations can be found in what follows. The main text should start with a short, comprehensive abstract stating what has been achieved in the work.

1. INTRODUCTION

Papers must be **four pages** in length and written in English. Papers should be in **A4 size**.

The **title** of the paper should be centred and given in **bold capitals** at the top of the first page.

Leave one blank line between the title and the centred **authors' names** given in **capital letters** with numerical identifiers as shown above.

Leave another blank line between the authors' names and their addresses. The **addresses** should also be centred and in normal text. The numerical identifiers should be used as shown above. Start a newline for each address. The **email address** of the corresponding author can be provided below the last address line. Then leave two blank lines above the main body of the paper.

The **main text** must be presented in **two columns** as in this document. Justify the text in each column on both the right- and left-hand sides. Do not indent paragraphs. Leave one blank line between paragraphs.

Leave one blank line before the heading of a new section. **Section headings** must be in **bold cap-**

itals and all sections except for the abstract and references should be numbered. Leave another blank line below each section heading before the start of the text.

Please **submit** the paper not later than **30th of March 2018** as a pdf file through the EasyChair portal of GD 2018 conference (<https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=gd2018>). Detailed instructions are available on the conference website. Papers could be written using Microsoft Word or LaTeX. *Please note that the submitted paper should be in press-ready form. It will be printed in grayscale while the electronic version of the paper will be in colour.*

2. MARGINS AND COLUMNS

Top margin = 20 mm;

Bottom margin = 30 mm;

Left and right margins = 25 mm;

Column width = 77 mm;

Margin between columns = 6 mm

3. FONTS AND SIZINGS

The **main text** should be set in Times New Roman or something very similar in 11 points.

The **title** must be in 14 point bold.

The **authors' names** and **addresses** must be in 12 point as shown.

For **figure captions** and **tables** only, an 8 point font size may be used.

4. FURTHER GUIDELINES

- Use italics for **mathematical symbols**.
- Use rounded brackets (1) for **equations** and square brackets [1] for **references**.
- Define abbreviations and acronyms when they first appear.
- Insert figures and tables after they are cited in the text; try to place figures and tables at the tops or bottoms of pages.
- **Figures** must be numbered (Fig. 1, Fig. 1(a), etc.) below the figure with legends running on from this.
- Incorporate photographs and figures into the text.

- **Table** headings (Table 1, etc.) must appear above the tables with the captions running on from the heading.
- **Colour** printing will not be used in the proceedings, only for electronic version.
- Large figures and tables may span both columns if necessary.
- **SI units** must be used when units are required.
- **Do not give page numbers.**
- Use spacings if necessary in order to avoid having section headings at the bottom of columns.
- Try to equalize the lengths of the columns on the final page.
